# Cavalier Match 

Wednesday

All stages are 10 rifle 10 pistol and $4+$ shotgun unless otherwise stated in stage writing with long guns staged on prop, pistols holstered and hands on hat or head

Stage 1: Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun
When ready say so. At the beep with rifle shoot the two $R$ targets with alternating double taps. Next, alternate double taps on the two P targets. Last with shotgun KD any four KD's.

Stage 2: Pistol, Rifle, Shotgun
When ready say so. At the beep with pistols shoot the two $P$ targets with a Military Sweep, which is left, left, left, right, left and repeat. Next, with rifle repeat instructions on the two R targets, Last, with shotgun shoot the two upper then four lower KD's.

Stage 3: Shotgun, Rifle, Pistol
When ready say so. At the beep with shotgun shoot any four KD's. Next, with rifle shoot the two $R$ targets with a Progressive Sweep, ex. 1,2,2,1,1,1,2,2,2,2. Last, with pistols shoot the two $P$ targets with the same instructions as the rifle.

Stage 4: Rifle, Pistol, Shotgun
When ready say so. At the beep with rifle shoot the two R targets in this order, $1,1,2,2,1,2,1,1,2,2$. Next, with pistols shoot the two $P$ targets the same. Last, with shotgun shoot any four KD's.

Stage 5: Shotgun, Pistol, Rifle, Shotgun
When ready say so. At the beep with shotgun shoot the four lower KD's. Next, with pistols shoot the two $P$ targets in this order $1,2,2,1,2,2,1,2,2,1$. Then, with rifle shoot the two $R$ targets the same. Last, with shotgun shoot the two upper KD's.

Stage 6: Shotgun, Rifle, Pistol
When ready say so. At the beep with shotgun shoot any four KD's. Next, with rifle shoot the two $R$ targets with 5 rounds each (no quad taps). Last, with pistols shoot the two $P$ targets with same instructions as the rifle.
